OBJECTIVE

CNIGA is looking to partner with a vendor that can create an exclusive Wide Area Progressive to be played only in CNIGA member casinos. The WAP can be Class II or III machines.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. Machine(s)
 - A. Must be certified by a California recognized gaming laboratory.
 - B. Should be able to integrate with most common player club systems.
 - C. Should be attractive and exciting game type and themes – possibly unique
 - D. Flexible on the denomination and can be downloadable
2. System
 - A. Must be able to create industry standard reports including daily, monthly and YTD win per unit and “coin –in”
 - B. Must be able to send reports electronically by property to CNIGA as well as the local property.
 - C. Must be certified by a California recognized gaming laboratory.
 - D. Must be linkable to multi-properties.
 - E. Must be user friendly to repair and maintain online reliability
3. Reporting
 - A. Must provide daily reports to both local property and CNIGA
 - B. Must use industry standard terms on reports (coin-in, drop...)

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES
